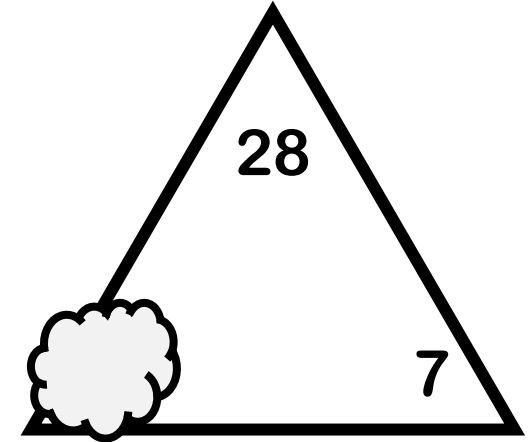
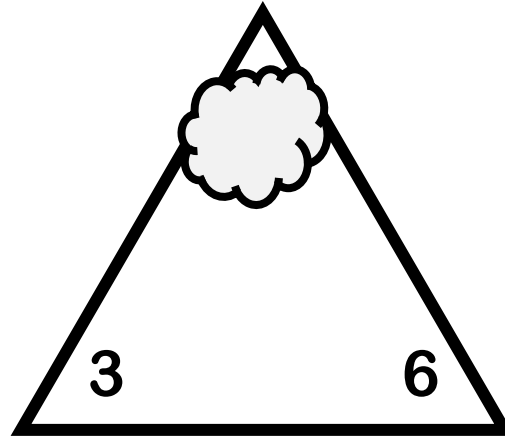
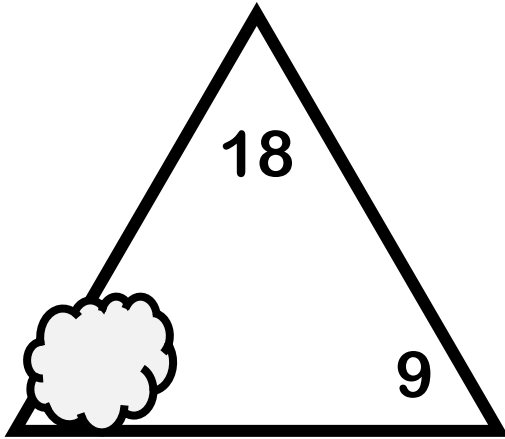
Numbers 21 and 32

Numbers of the week... 21 and 32!

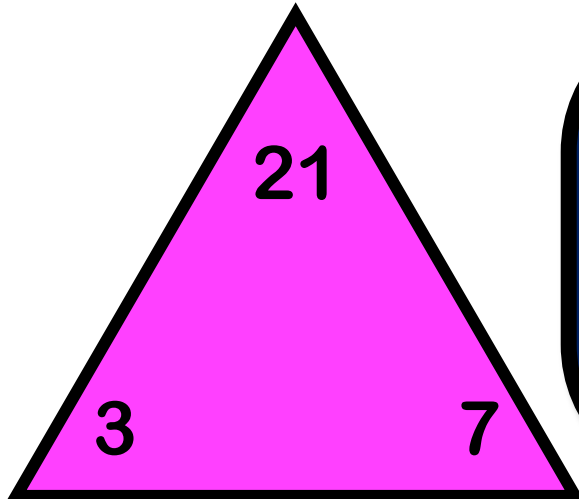
Notes for teachers in school or at home:

- This week is about learning the multiplication facts for 21 and 32.
- Know that 21 has 1 key fact: 3×7 .
- Recognise 21 in context: 3 weeks, 7 threes...
- Know that 32 has 1 key fact: 4×8
- Understand that 32 is double 16
- Know division and fraction facts for each number.

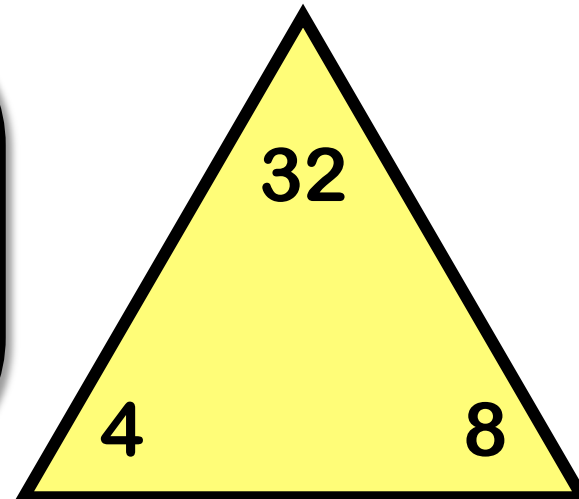
Last week we learned 3 factor triangles...
